Saturday, August 23, 2008: Field trip to Emerald Creek area and Hobo Cedar Grove. Dr. Bill Rember will lead this activity. The morning will be spent at Bill's fossil beds, about 10 miles west of Clarkia, where Bill will describe the paleohistory of the area and lead us in exploring for fossils. The area is abundant with fossilized leaves, from an era when the region was warmer and wetter, with a climate and ecology similar to that of the current southeastern U.S. We will then travel to the nearby Hobo Cedar Grove for lunch, followed by an easy walk through the big trees. Return time to Moscow is 5 pm or earlier, depending upon participant desires. Meet at Eastside Marketplace in Moscow, south end, at 8:00 a.m. Carpools will be organized. Bring: Lunch, water, and fossil collecting materials (old pocket knife or butter knife, newspapers, and bags).

Saturday, September 20, noon: Annual Potluck at Great White Pine Campground (about 45 min. from Moscow; drive north from Moscow on HW 95; turn right onto HW 6 at the Potlatch junction; continue east past Potlatch, Harvard, and Princeton, past Laird Park and on to the White Pine Campground parking lot on the right). **Meet at Rosauer's for carpooling at 11 a.m. Bring:** A dish to share, your own place setting and beverage. There will be a brief chapter meeting, followed by an opportunity to hike the trails. A link to the campground / trail information will be available on the website schedule later.
