

The dynamic influence of climate and fire on aspen forests of the western U.S.



Presentation and Discussion

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The health and persistence of aspen forests on western U.S. landscapes are influenced by multiple factors, including climate variability, fire, herbivory, pathogens, and land use. Declines in aspen forests in many regions could lead to substantial habitat loss for a myriad of species that disproportionately utilize them. Understanding how altered fire regimes and changing climate conditions will affect aspen, including through interactions with other stressors, can help land managers to identify, prioritize, and manage at-risk aspen forests.
